# JCMA Schools Presenter (Casual Part time)

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Jewish Christian Muslim Association of Australia (JCMA) is a not for profit, volunteer based organisation whose objective is to promote the prevention of emotional and physical abuse arising from religious intolerance and cultural discrimination. To achieve its objectives JCMA works to draw together members of the Abrahamic faiths in mutual respect, seeking to appreciate and understand each other by engaging in dialogue and delivering programs that create a shared experience. One of JCMA's programs is the Schools Program

Established in 2003, the Schools Program is available in Melbourne and regional Victoria. It's designed to enhance students' understanding of different faiths and cultural traditions through a variety of workshops. Most workshops link to the VCE curriculum (e.g. Religion and Society) by providing real life examples of the faiths in a modern Australian context.

Our flagship, and most popular, workshop has three presenters, a Jew, a Christian and a Muslim deliver an interactive 90 minute session. The presenters demonstrate a positive intercultural interaction and engage the students with an open Q&A session. The workshop encourages acceptance of diversity and difference and invites students to show empathy towards those different from themselves.
