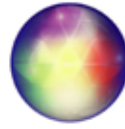

The Intercultural Understanding Partnership (ICUP) is a national initiative created by [Together For Humanity \(TFH\)](#) and funded by the Australian Government.

ICUP provides opportunities for you to work closely with TFH and its partners, the [Jewish Christian Muslim Association \(JCMA\)](#) in Victoria and [The Abraham Institute](#) in South Australia, to address a cross-cultural challenge in your school community.

If your ICUP application is successful, you will receive **up to \$10,000** to address your challenge and improve the learning and wellbeing of your students. You will also have the **opportunity to work collaboratively with an experienced ICUP facilitator**, located in your state or territory, throughout your project.

ICUP 2021: A snapshot



The first ICUP Grants were offered in 2020-21

- 35 schools
- 5 states
- 27 projects
- >\$179,000 to address cross-cultural challenges

Participating schools included small and large, public and private, primary and secondary schools in metropolitan and regional areas.



Projects addressed a range of issues including:

- increased incidents of racism as a result of COVID
- challenges in schools with a high number of refugee enrolments
- providing regional students with an understanding of, and connection to, people from different cultures
- facilitating greater belonging for Indigenous students and more
