

ENGAGING PARENTS AND FAMILIES FROM DIVERSE CULTURAL BACKGROUNDS

A positive and productive partnership between school and parents is crucial to improving wellbeing and learning outcomes in students! Forming and nurturing these partnerships can often be challenging, especially when trying to engage with parents and families from diverse cultural and faith backgrounds.

Our teacher Professional Development (PD) examines this challenge, presenting insights and strategies that schools can use to improve their engagement with families from diverse backgrounds. We use case studies, research and our experience from working with schools across Australia.

This diversity and family engagement PD is a collaboration between the Jewish Christian Muslim Association (JCMA) in Victoria, Together for Humanity (TFH) and the Australian Council of State School Organisations (ACSSO).

What Do We Offer?

A 1.5 hour session, which can be extended to 2 or 3 hours. Longer sessions will incorporate extra activities and applications relevant to your school. Topics include:

1. Culture And Faith

We explore surface and deep level culture, differing worldviews, faith and other drivers that influence people's attitudes towards education.

2. Families And Generational Issues

In examining various understanding of family, we discuss cross-cultural and generational dimensions, as well as exploring migrant/refugee experiences.

3. Classroom And School Strategies

We present the principles which support improved parent and family engagement. Reflection and discussion on how these principles can be applied to your school context are an integral aspect of the PD.

4. Case Studies

We explore how several schools have responded to challenges they are experiencing in engaging parents, especially from diverse cultural backgrounds – successes, surprises and lessons learned.
